The Chinese authorities do not publish estimates of GDP at constant prices. Their volume index is constructed by linking five time segments. Each segment is weighted with the price structure of successive base years. Thus this table is not strictly speaking at constant 1987 prices. The 1987 appellation is simply a reference point or numeraire. It is possible to re–estimate the official GDP measure at 1987 prices, using detailed branch and sector information, as shown in Tables C.9 and C.10. The GDP figure in the last column of Table C.10 is represented as an index number by the dotted line in Figure C.1, whereas the figures in the present table are represented by the top line in Figure C.1.
